Clone: 65 percent Pommard (UCD5), 35  
percent Wädenswil (UCD2A),

Yield: 1.7 tons per acre

Cellar: Spontaneous fermentation in 2.5 ton  
stainless tank and 1.5 ton bin after circa  
seven days cold-soak, 13 days total skin  
contact. Eleven months in French oak, 33  
1/3 percent new.

Production: 150 cases

Alcohol by volume: 14.5 percent

Bottled: September 1, 2016

Lia's Vineyard is a series of slopes and benches. Our "Jory Bench Reserve" highlights fruit from own-rooted Pommard and Wädenswil vines growing on a fine bench of Jory soil at the top of the vineyard. The exuberant nose of our 2015 Jory Bench Reserve prepares you for the rich, red fruit on the palate. The finish is long and lingering with a touch of spice.

This wine reminds us of our favorite pop music from the seventies - approachable but something we find enjoyable on repeat visits.

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
