Our 2010 Lia's Vineyard Pinot Noir highlights fruit from our 115 clone which always has a wonderful pie cherry flavor and distinctive floral nose. Aromas of rose petals, redcurrant and cranberry, On the palate the bright fruit leads, accompanied by mint and hard candy notes. The finish is clean and thirst quenching with a pleasant hint of grip.

The wine reminds of us our favorite 60s rock: Bright and lively with a freshness that is found only in things that aren't over-produced.
